

**CITY OF THROCKMORTON
CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
OCTOBER 9, 2018**

1. Mayor Will Carroll called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following council members present: Susie Oliver, Corey Keeter and Judy Jackson. Council members Brad Bellah and Ricky Escalon were absent. Others present were: Melanie Gober, City Secretary and Doc Wigington, Sheriff. Will Carroll gave the invocation.
2. The Council reviewed and approved the minutes from the September 11th, 2018 regular meeting.

Mayor Carroll reported the City received the RAMP Grant again this year; the creek clean-out has been delayed due to the rain but will begin as soon as possible; the Skid Steer was received and has been paid in full; Cathey Lee is continuing the renovations to the mural on the north side of the building and hopes to have it completed by Homecoming; Jacob and Martin are continuing their efforts to clear up the waste water violations, the City received an extension from TCEQ until November 25, 2018; Sheriff Wigington complimented the City workers for their efforts in warning people of the high water by quickly putting up barriers to prevent accidents; Susie Oliver requested the City to try to improve the drainage problem in front of her parents house on N. Massie, Mayor Carroll reported that it had been looked into in the past but would be checked into again.
