Mayor Carroll reported plans to do repairs at the airport as soon as weather permits using RAMP Grant funds; the pond liner inspection at the Waste Water Plant was completed, this is a requirement by TCEQ and cost the City over \$5000.00; another TCEQ requirement that is going to been done is to have the Imhoff Tank pumped out, Dow Tech will come and do this with the cost being approximately \$13,000.00; November 25th, 2018 was the deadline to get the required materials in to TCEQ to renew our Waste Water Permit, this was done by the deadline; the Sprinkler System at the Waste Water Plant is another requirement of TCEQ that we are working on; The City contacted Heatley Surveying out of Breckenridge and they agreed to survey the east end of Washington Street. It is platted as a City street but isn't open at this time. This will be as soon as Heatley's can get to it; Sheriff Wigington addressed the Council regarding the hiring of another deputy for the Sheriff's Department. Sheriff Wigington reported hiring C.J. Saucedo, his start date is January 7th, 2019;
- 4. Old Business: Water Rates outside the City Limits were discussed; no action was taken.
- The Council discussed continuing to use Hudson Energy as the energy provider for the City of Throckmorton.
