



**CITY OF THROCKMORTON
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
July 10, 2018**

1. Mayor Will Carroll called the city council meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with council members Corey Keeter, Susie Oliver, Brad Bellah, Judy Jackson and Ricky Escalon present. Also present was Melanie Gober- City Secretary and Terry Armstrong-Throckmorton Tribune. Invocation was given by Susie Oliver.
2. Council members discussed the minutes from the June 12th, 2018 regular Meeting.

3. The drainage issue on Richards Street was repaired prior to this meeting, no one was present to address the issue.
4. There was no one present for Citizens Participation. Mayor Carroll reported:
Mowing and street repairs are continuing; A Skid-Steer has been ordered for the Public Works Department. The funds to pay for it will be divided between the General and Economic Development Funds. ¼ will be paid from the General Fund and ¾ will be paid from the Economic Development Funds since it will primarily be used for street repairs. The skid-steer should arrive around the 1st of August; New Banners to replace the ones that are presently hanging on Minter and Chestnut Street have been ordered from Hall signs, they will be put up as soon as they arrive; Mayor Carroll will be attending Municipal Judge's training July 15th through July 21st, this is a requirement that he receive this training in order to be the City of Throckmorton's Municipal Judge.
5. The new Administrative position for the City of Throckmorton was discussed.

6. Council discussed the financial report. This month's bills were reviewed and discussed by the Council
