3. Citizen's Participation:

Mayor Carroll reported that a representative from the Texas Community Development Block Grant met with Jimmy to take pictures of what work would be done if we get the grant. The rep told Jimmy that we had not been chosen as of yet for the grant but for them to send him to take pictures of the sites, it was a good sign. Mayor Carroll met with engineers a few weeks back and the \$275,000 dollar grant would be used in replacing the water line behind the Assembly of God, rehab the filters at the water plant and replacing the carbon dioxide shed, along with other things on the list. The city is due this grant and hopefully we will be hearing from TCDG soon.

The city has had a few code enforcement activities and had to hire someone to clean up a few bigger jobs which is costing the city. The protocol for the code enforcement actions is, citizen receives the citation and within a certain time frame, they are to clean up property. If the owner takes action then that is all that needs to be done if they do not comply then the city has an opportunity to go and clean the property. A bill is sent to the owner and if they do not pay, the Texas Community Group can issue a lien on that property.

The city had a dog incident where the animal control officer had to serve papers to an individual deeming their dogs dangerous. These dogs have not bit anyone but have chased people that have hurt themselves trying to get away from them. They have up to 15 days if they want to appeal the served papers and then go by the steps of which court they choose. They have to keep the dogs restrained at all times on a leash in the immediate control of the owner, and will have to obtain liability insurance on each dog.
