

**CITY OF THROCKMORTON
MEETING MINUTES
JUNE 8th, 2021**

1. Mayor Will Carroll called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. with council members Ricky Escalon, Susie Oliver, and Cathey Lee present. Judy Jackson was absent. Also present were, Angie Scarlett- City Secretary. Invocation was given by Mayor Carroll.

2. **Council Members approved the minutes from the May 11th, 2021 Regular Meeting.**

3. **Citizens Participation**

Mayor Carroll reported:

1. Not much road patching has started because of all the heavy rains lately and weather conditions have to be very dry and hot for street materials to work effectively. Cathey Lee mentioned that she had talked to Clay Mitchell about the county helping with some of the streets that will need more repairs than just patching and he agreed that they would be willing to help out. Mayor Carroll added that what we would need from the county if they decided to help out, would be a dump truck and grater. A load of asphalt costs between \$2500 dollars to \$3,000 with one full load used for one street.

2. Four projects are in motion for the city at this time and they are; The already granted, \$275, 000 with the TXCDBG for repairs to water plant and several main water lines. \$300, 000 Downtown project has been submitted and we are waiting to hear of the next step by July. Mr. Scroggins, with the windfarms has requested a list from the city and it has been submitted but no word back from him yet. Lastly, approximately \$188,000 dollars will be distributed to the city through the American Rescue Plan. Plans for projects with this money will be discussed with Jimmy this week.

3. The RV Park was discussed and also the many RV parks that are being developed inside the city by local residents. This has taken much time and effort of our city workers as they are working diligently putting in new water and sewer taps. Susie Oliver asked if the city might consider raising our rates or maybe even the possibility of adding on a few more RV spots. With so many new people coming to town to work on the windmills, we now have about 8 to 10 extended stay residents at the park.

4. **Accept Council Nomination to fill vacant council position.**

to nominate Lester Moses for the empty seat on the council.

Motion carried 3-0.

5. **Pay Bills/ Financial Officers report on Finances and Budget**
