Mayor Carroll went to Irving on August 14<sup>th</sup> August 15<sup>th</sup> to attend the prep course for Class B Water Test on August 27<sup>th</sup> in Wichita Falls. When he passes the test and receives his Class B Water license the City will be able to run the water plant under his license. TCEQ was here last week for their annual inspection; we received a good report with only four citations issued that were easily fixed.
