Mr. Laje,

The City of Throckmorton does not have the ability to pay the fine assessed us for violations at our wastewater treatment facility. We have endured over 3 years of drought and surviving on an emergency water line with water purchased from Graham Texas. The emergency situation caused the city's revenues to be depleted even though we raised rates and did not hire a Public Works director position after it was vacated in 2012. The 3 years of drought also caused our water treatment facility to sit idle and our raw water pumps not to be used. The result of this extended idle period without operation resulted in over \$40,000 in repair costs and a bank loan which will take years to pay.

Our wastewater treatment facility also was under strain because of a lack of water flow which caused a 300 percent increase in chemical and operations costs and adding to our already strained finances. The drought caused a strain on all areas of the city's finances and all available funds are being used to "catch up" on needed repairs, equipment and staff.

The City of Throckmorton has been recovering and will continue to do so. I believe if the fine is \$20,000 or \$2 it will not change the desire we have to provide safe and adequate services to our citizens. We are working to best of our ability to right any wrong and make sure all regulations are in compliance in the future.

As a City recovering from an emergency extended drought, we have delayed vehicle purchases and currently our public works department uses only 3 vehicles owned by the city. The current vehicles are in need of replacement and consist of a 1999 Dodge and 2- 2005 Chevrolet trucks.

We have applied for grants to repair failing water and wastewater infrastructure but did not score high enough on the grant application, so these repairs have been postponed. We have raised all fund rates and taxes in an effort to recover revenue and raise money to pay for repair and equipment loans. As I mentioned before, the city has lapsed the highest position in our Public Works department for over 3 years in an effort to decrease cost to the city and recover revenue.

I would ask that a fine of \$1,000 or less, be assed the city for these violations.

On February 4, 2016, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("TCEQ" or "Commission") informed you that we were in receipt of requested financial disclosure documents, which were forwarded to the TCEQ's Revenue Operations Section for review to determine if the TCEQ agrees with the City of Throckmorton's claim of financial inability to pay administrative penalties. An extension of time for reaching an agreement on the proposed agreed order was also granted until such time to the completion of the review.

The TCEQ's Revenue Operations Section has completed its review and has determined that the City of Throckmorton does not have the financial capability to pay the full administrative penalty and recommends a full deferral of the payable penalty.
